Please make checks payable to North Grounds Softball League and put your team name on the check. Every roster must be accompanied by the entry fee. **All rosters and entry fees are due by 5:00 PM, Wednesday, September 7.** Return rosters, liability waiver, and entry fees (stapled or clipped together) to the box outside the NGSL office (SL 158B). Please note the attached field/rule reminders; these are not all of the rules, but they are ones NGSL wants to highlight. **There will be a mandatory captain's meeting at 6:00 PM, Wednesday, September 7 in WB105.** All teams must have at least one representative present.

Players not previously on a team's roster may be added to the team's roster at any time during the season, provided the additional player's presence does not violate any other rule, and the Head Commissioner and Head Umpire are notified prior to the addition.

REMINDER: Please take note of the playoff roster rules when forming your team. Players in both leagues may only play for one unaffiliated team and any team with whom they are affiliated.

SCHEDULING: This semester we will be assigning opponents for every week. With the exception of 1L Section Teams, we will not be scheduling specific game times. It is the responsibility of the captains to agree on the best available time to play during the assigned week. Captains may schedule games only 2 weeks in advance. Games not played in the assigned week may be made up at a later date, or during the makeup week between the regular season and the playoffs. Games that are not played will count against those teams for playoff seeding purposes, and the lowest seeded teams may not make the playoffs. 4. Co-Rec teams must have at least 3 females to avoid a forfeit. A female must bat at least every third batter. In order to have 10 players in the field, at least 4 must be female.
5. There is no such thing as “breaking up the double play” in UVA Law softball. Additionally, collisions at home plate are not allowed.
6. **Please review the rules at www.ngsl.com. There are important rules regarding ejections, game time limits, and sportsmanship. Please familiarize yourself with these rules.**
